Northumbria University is now ranked in the top 30 universities in the UK after a significant 20 place rise in The Guardian University Guide 2021. Northumbria has climbed to 27th place overall and has the best score in the UK in the value-added measure.

## All hands to the sanitiser pump for young entrepreneur

Fraser Mair, who graduated in 2019 from the Business with Marketing Management course, has turned a free hand sanitiser project into a £100,000 per month business in just 12 weeks. With the lockdown causing a dip in sales at his family's small gin distillery, production was switched to making a World Health Organisation approved formula. He produced 15,000 bottles of free hand sanitiser for frontline workers and is now selling the product to companies that have placed large corporate orders.
