Apply for our new Sport Scholarship

To help students from all backgrounds succeed, we have launched a new sport scholarship to enable the next generation of coaches and officials to prosper. Our new sport scholarship will enable students to achieve their ambitions as sport leaders and it will support female coaches and officials in the first year of study. Women make up only 18% of qualified coaches and, despite recent developments, including women refereeing at the 2022 men's football World Cup, they remain under-represented in sport.
