KEY TASKS TO COMPLETE - CHECKLIST

To get started on your course you will need to complete a number of key tasks. The checklist below will help you. Further guidance can be found in our <u>Getting Started at</u> <u>Northumbria</u> web pages and <u>Ask4Help Online</u> on your Student Portal.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Enrol - step 1 of 2: Pre-register - Click the 'Enrol' link in your Student Portal and follow the online enrolment instructions.

Activate DUO Multi-Factor Authentication.

Get to know your **<u>Student Portal</u>**.

INDUCTION WEEK

Enrol - step 2 of 2: Complete your enrolment - Upload your visa documents for verification via the "Visa Upload" button in your Student Portal.

Collect your BRP (Biometric Residence Permit) and upload a copy to your Student Portal.

Collect your Smartcard.

Access your timetable.

Pay your fees.

Take part in your programme Induction.

You will need your username and password to access the Student Portal which will have been sent to you in two separate emails.

- If you have not received your username or password, please <u>contact Applicant Services</u>.

LIVING IN THE UK

Opening a bank account - Depending on the length of time you plan to stay in the UK, you may consider <u>opening a UK bank account</u> to make it easier for you to make and receive payments. However, specific eligibility criteria may apply depending on the type of visa you hold and the individual bank's policies - check with the bank for details.

Registering with a Doctor (General Practitioner) - Once you have arrived in the UK you should <u>register with a doctor</u> as soon as possible. If you didn't pay the Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS) and obtain an IHS number as part of your visa application, you may wish to consider taking out private health insurance as <u>visitors to the UK are</u> required to pay for NHS medical treatment.
