

Sustainability Engagement Plan

As a challenger institution, Northumbria seeks ways to continuously evolve and improve in all areas, including in our sustainability performance and activity. Our **University Strategy 2024-2030** recognises that ssustainability is the biggest challenge facing humanity, and includes the following commitment:

'Through innovative research, education and collaboration, we will strive to empower future leaders, contribute to the global transition towards a greener and more equitable future and create a sustainable campus. We will foster a culture of environmental responsibility and social impact. By demonstrating our own commitment to operating sustainably, we will look to influence those that we work with and work through.

Our commitment must therefore be deep-rooted. We are integrating sustainability into our taught curriculum, so that all Northumbria students learn about the sustainable development challenges that we face and can become sustainability leaders. We are investing in cutting-edge research to address pressing sustainability challenges and drive real-world impact, building on successes such as the Renewable Energy Northeast Universities Centre for Doctoral Training.

Through partnerships we will share knowledge and amplify our impact.

We will build on the successful implementation of our carbon management plan to date, which sets out our aim to halve our carbon emissions in Newcastle by 2030 on the way to achieving net zero by 2040. Our partner that operates our London campus, QA, is also committed to achieving net zero by 2040. We will work with them to ensure that developments at our London campus support this goal and with other partners to support their progress towards net zero.'

To support this, the University is optimising its contribution to the SDGs through our research and teaching, as well as further improvements to the sustainability of our campus and operations, with areas of focus including reduced carbon emissions and waste.

Key to delivering our Strategy Commitments is the need to deliver effective engagement and communications amongst staff, students and the communities in which we work. Our engagement activity around sustainability has three aims:

- Inform and Encourage: To help our stakeholders understand more about sustainability challenges and to encourage them to adopt behaviours that support the SDGs at Northumbria and beyond.
- **Shared Voices:** To gather the views of our students and staff and to use these to shape our sustainability agenda and associated activity.
- **Promote:** To raise staff, student and public awareness of Northumbria's sustainability successes.

This Sustainability Engagement Plan is overseen by the University Sustainability Management Group (USMG). It is reviewed annually by the USMG with interim oversight /coordination completed by the Sustainability Manager. It is reported on annually in the Sustainability Annual Report.
