**Attendance Requirements:** A minimum of 50 paid hours over the year with additional voluntary hours to be performed by the Ambassador

## **Role Activities:**

- Support international recruitment activities in the UK and overseas, specifically Amsterdam Campus AUAS 2019/20 cohort
- Promote the partnership between Northumbria University and AUAS and the course offer
- Develop and maintain excellent working relationships with AUAS colleagues and AUAS Students' Union
- Develop recruitment-related publicity and marketing information including web profile
- Take part in publicity and events including photo shoots
- Develop digital and hard copy resources for recruitment activities
- Maintain a blog including regular blog posts about Northumbria University and AUAS e.g. course information and city information
- Support on-campus activities with current and prospective students such as focus groups, welcome events and graduation
- Deliver campus and accommodation tours
- Support communication with prospective students such as emails, social media, phone calls
- Attend initial training sessions and meetings when required, being punctual and maintain regular contact with International Development and Marketing staff
- Undertake other responsibilities as required
