

HOW-TO... access your student allocation


When a student is allocated to a service for which you have responsibility, you should receive an automated e-mail advising you that an allocation has been made to one or more of your services and that the information is available to view via PEP. The e-mail will also provide the start date(s) of the placement(s) to be undertaken

To view your allocation, follow these steps:


- 1. Log into PEP you should see a list of the services you are responsible for beneath the search box
- 2. Choose the relevant service from the list and click on the eye symbol see below example:



3. You should now be in your service's profile and will be able to see a menu running left to right across the page:



- 4. Click on the 'students' link within the menu
- 5. Now enter the date range that appears in the e-mail you received by clicking into the 'date from' and then 'date to' boxes in turn and using the calendar to select the relevant dates:







6. Click 'show students' and a list of the students allocated to your service on placement will be shown, together with the dates and type of their placement and the students' e-mail addresses:



7. To find out the student's recall day, click on the plus sign next to the student's name to view the name of the students tutor.



You can then find out the student's recall day by clicking here, selecting Information for Placement Providers, scrolling down to the recall day information and selecting the relevant link. The intake code and year of placement can be found in the above information.
