APPLYING TO STUDY OVERSEAS FOR AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CAN BE COMPLICATED, SO WE'VE CREATED THIS HANDY GUIDE TO MAKE THE PROCESS EASIER FOR YOU.

International Undergraduate (UG) students can apply via three routes;

- 2 Online via **UCAS**
- 3 With support from one of our **In-Country Global Offices** or our **UK-based International Recruitment Team**

International Postgraduate (PG) students can apply via two routes;

THE STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



STEP 1 CHOOSE YOUR COURSE

Visit www.northumbria.ac.uk/study to explore which of our courses is the one for you.

STEP 2 SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

You can apply to us via **UCAS** (UG only), the relevant course page on our website, or with the help of one of our **Global Offices** that represent your country. Don't forget to submit any supporting documents.



STEP 5 ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

To confirm your place with us, you'll need to log into Northumbria's **Applicant Portal** or **UCAS** to accept your place.

STEP 4 UPLOAD YOUR DOCUMENTATION

If you've received a conditional offer, you'll need to submit any outstanding documents or evidence required. You should also supply translations if any of your documents are not in English. Depending on the course, you may be asked to provide further information, submit a portfolio, or attend an interview.

STEP 3 RECEIVE YOUR DECISION

You will receive your decision from us via **UCAS** or Northumbria's **Applicant Portal** depending on how you submitted your application. We'll also send you an email.



STEP 6 BOOK YOUR ACCOMMODATION

You'll receive details on how to apply for your accommodation. We guarantee to find all new international students' **accommodation** and you can even select your own room when you book.

STEP 7 PAY YOUR DEPOSIT

To secure your place with us, you'll need to pay your **tuition** fee deposit outlined in your offer letter.

STEP 8 REQUEST YOUR CAS*

Once you have met all the conditions of your offer and paid your deposit, you will need to request your **CAS** via CAS Shield.

*This step applies to applicants applying for a Student Route Visa only.



STEP 11 BOOK YOUR MEET & GREET

Once you know your arrival date, we have a dedicated team who will **meet** you at Newcastle International Airport and support you with transport to your accommodation. This is a free service but you must book in advance.

STEP 10 BOOK YOUR FLIGHTS

Once you have your **VISA** you can **book your flights** to the UK.

STEP 9 APPLY FOR YOUR VISA*

Once you receive your CAS you can apply for your Student Route **VISA** (if applicable). It is important to prepare your visa application in good time so you can arrive in time for your induction.

*This step applies to applicants applying for a Student Route Visa only.



STEP 12 TRAVEL TO THE UK

Look out for a link to your **Welcome Pack** in your enrolment email - this contains lots of useful information including settling into Northumbria. Have a safe flight, we'll see you soon!

STEP 13 WELCOME TO NORTHUMBRIA

Once you arrive at Northumbria, you will need to start your enrolment by uploading your visa documentation, including your eVisa Share Code and boarding pass to your Student Portal (or CAS Shield if applicable). Once your visa has been verified, you can progress to completing your enrolment by following the Enrol Link in the Student Portal. Our induction and welcome events will help you find out more about life at Northumbria and make new friends from around the world. You will also be invited to the International Students; Welcome event, which will introduce you to the UK academic system and the resources and services available to you.

*Exception includes PGCE, where you apply directly to the professional body.
