Transitional Justice Institute, University of Ulster

Bill Rolston was the Director of the Transitional Justice Institute from 2010-2014 at the University of Ulster. His research interests focus on transitional justice and in particular the legacy of the Northern Ireland conflict and the complexities involved in dealing with the past. He has documented the experience of relatives of those killed by state forces and how they have embarked on a quest for truth and justice, analysed the way in which some victims' groups see memory as a tool not merely for telling stories but for pursuing justice; and explored the ways in which murals have been transformed by and in response to the developing peace process in Northern Ireland.

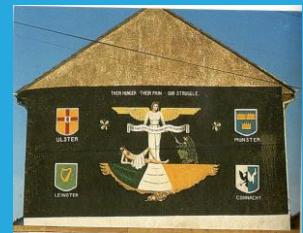
