Important!

When Northumbria staff are working externally in a third party organisation (e.g. as part of their research in a school/hospital), there may be DSOs and safeguarding procedures in that organisation that they should be familiar with. Staff should report any safeguarding concerns/allegations under their host's reporting arrangements in the first instance but if there is any uncertainty about where to report, they can also report use the above methods.
