

September - November

- New and returning students begin the academic year.
- Advertise your graduate, placements and internships vacancies.

PART TIME JOBS FAIR: for employers offering paid part time, seasonal and voluntary roles.

GRADUATE JOBS AND PLACEMENTS FAIR: for employers from all sectors offering graduate and placement roles for 2025 entry.

HINT: Autumn term is peak time to advertise graduate and placements roles.

DID YOU KNOW: Students can work up to 20 hours per week term time.

December - January

- Students available for seasonal work and work experience.
- Postgraduate student graduations - celebrating that success!

HINT: Students focus throughout January is on their assessment period.

DID YOU KNOW: Graduate schemes tend to close for application at the end of December.

February - March

- Students actively looking to secure placements during this period.

HINT: Second year students typically aim to secure a year-long placement before Easter.

DID YOU KNOW: Many students have the option to complete a short term/term time placement.

April - May

- End of teaching.

HINT: Employer engagement tends to fall outside of this period.

DID YOU KNOW: You can continue to advertise vacancies with us FREE of charge during this time.

June

- Undergraduate student graduations - celebrating that success!

HINT: Northumbria University graduates available for immediate start/full time employment.

DID YOU KNOW: Advertising with us means you can reach graduates for up to five years after graduation.

July - August

- End of the undergraduate academic year
- First and Second year students available for Summer Internships and Work Experience
- Second Year students available for placement year

HINT: Summer Internships can be anything from 4-12 weeks in duration.

DID YOU KNOW: Placement Years are full time and 30 - 48 weeks minimum in duration (dependent on programme of study).
